

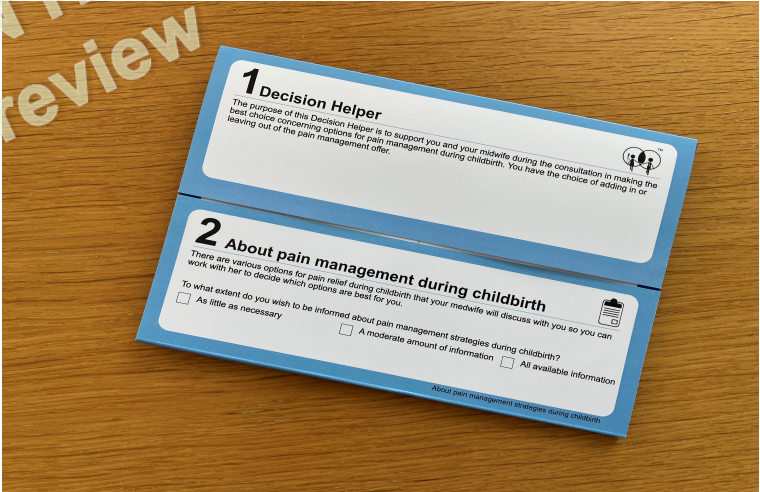
Dear Patient
